Named as one of the seven wonders of modern world, « **Petra** » also called “**The lost city of stone**”, is the greatest tourist attraction in Jordan and one of the world’s famous historical sites.

Petra is an ancient city carved into stones in the mountains of Jordan. It is situated 260 kilometers southern the capital Amman between the Dead Sea and the red sea.



The history of “**Petra**” started with nomadic Arab people. They first lived in tents then they carved houses in stones of the mountains. They practiced trade and commerce.

The city of Petra was the home for about 30 000 people including Romans, Nabataeans and businessmen from different part of the ancient world. The best-known of the monuments at Petra is the “Khazneh” or “Treasury” where tombs and temples of ancient kings are kept.

“**Petra**” was destroyed and fell into ruins in 106 AD by an earthquake. It was unknown until a Swiss explorer “Johann Ludwig” discovered it in 1812. The lost city was designated as a world heritage site by UNESCO in 1985.

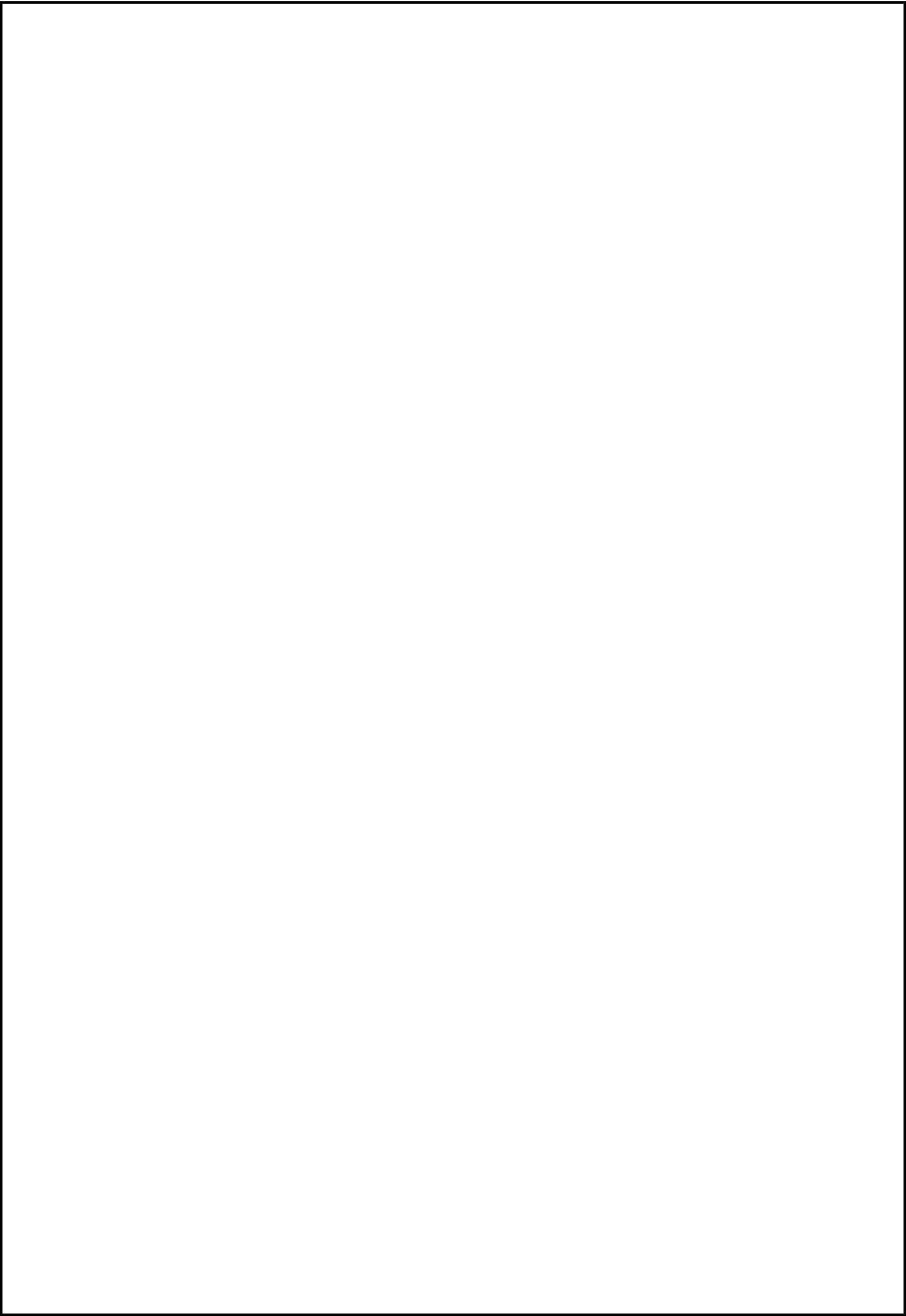

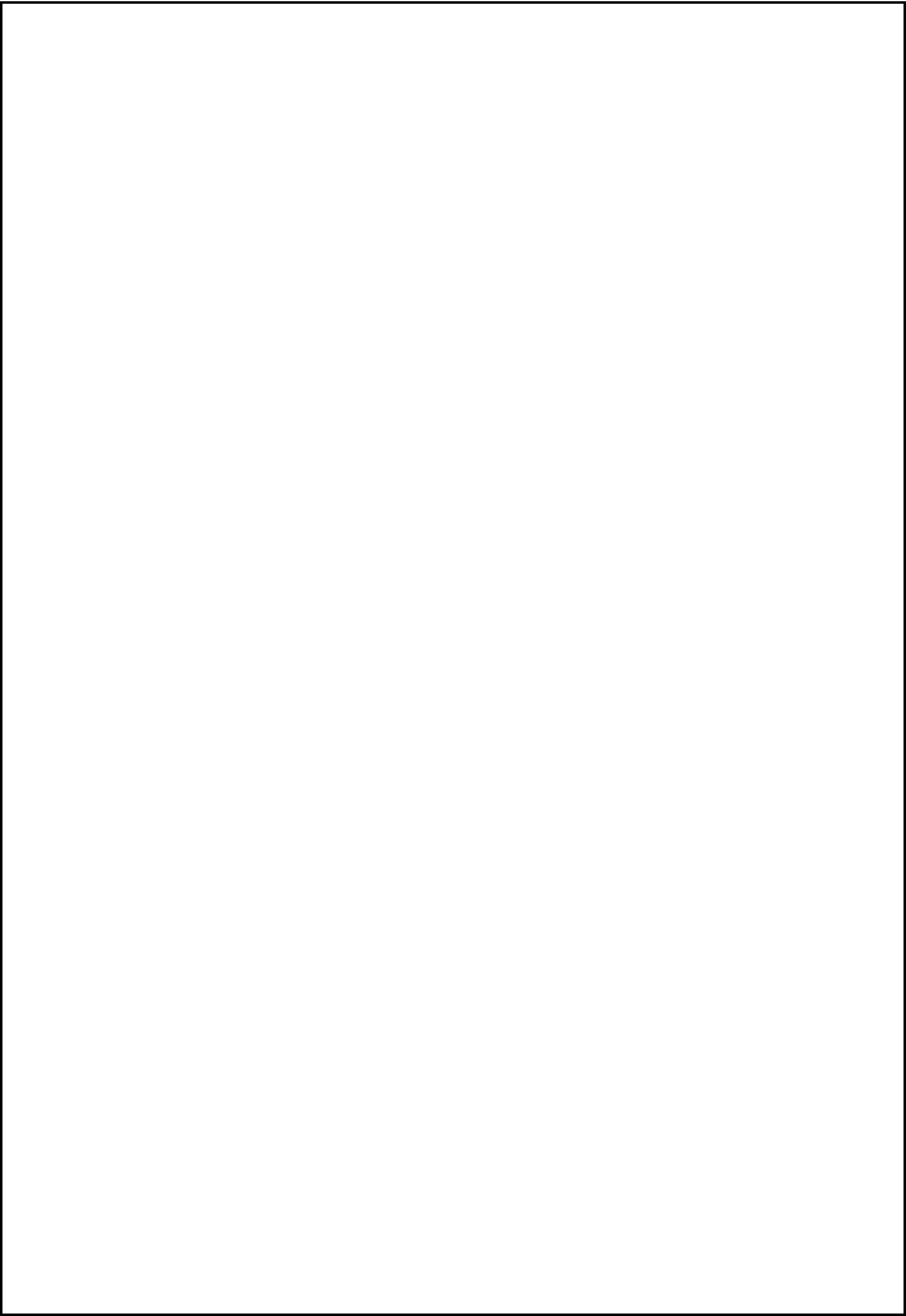

“The Great Mosque” also known as “Djamaa el Djazair” is situated in Algiers, Algeria. The Great Mosque is the third biggest mosque in the world after the Great Mosque of Mecca and Al-Masjid el Nabawi of Medina in Saudi Arabia.

The construction of the mosque began on August 16th 2012 and completed on April 29th 2019. It costs 898 million Euros. It was designed by a German architect KSP Jurgen Engel Architekten and constructed by a Chinese company.



The prayer hall has a capacity of 120.000 worshippers. The mosque contains a parking space for 7000 cars, a Quran School, a park, a library, fire station, a museum of Islamic arts, and a Research Center on the history of Algeria. The mosque was designed to stand an earthquake of magnitude 9.0. The prayer hall has 6 km of calligraphic writings engraved with a laser system. Its minaret high 265 meters which makes it the world's tallest minaret. The dome of the prayer hall is 70 meters high and it has a diameter of 50 m. 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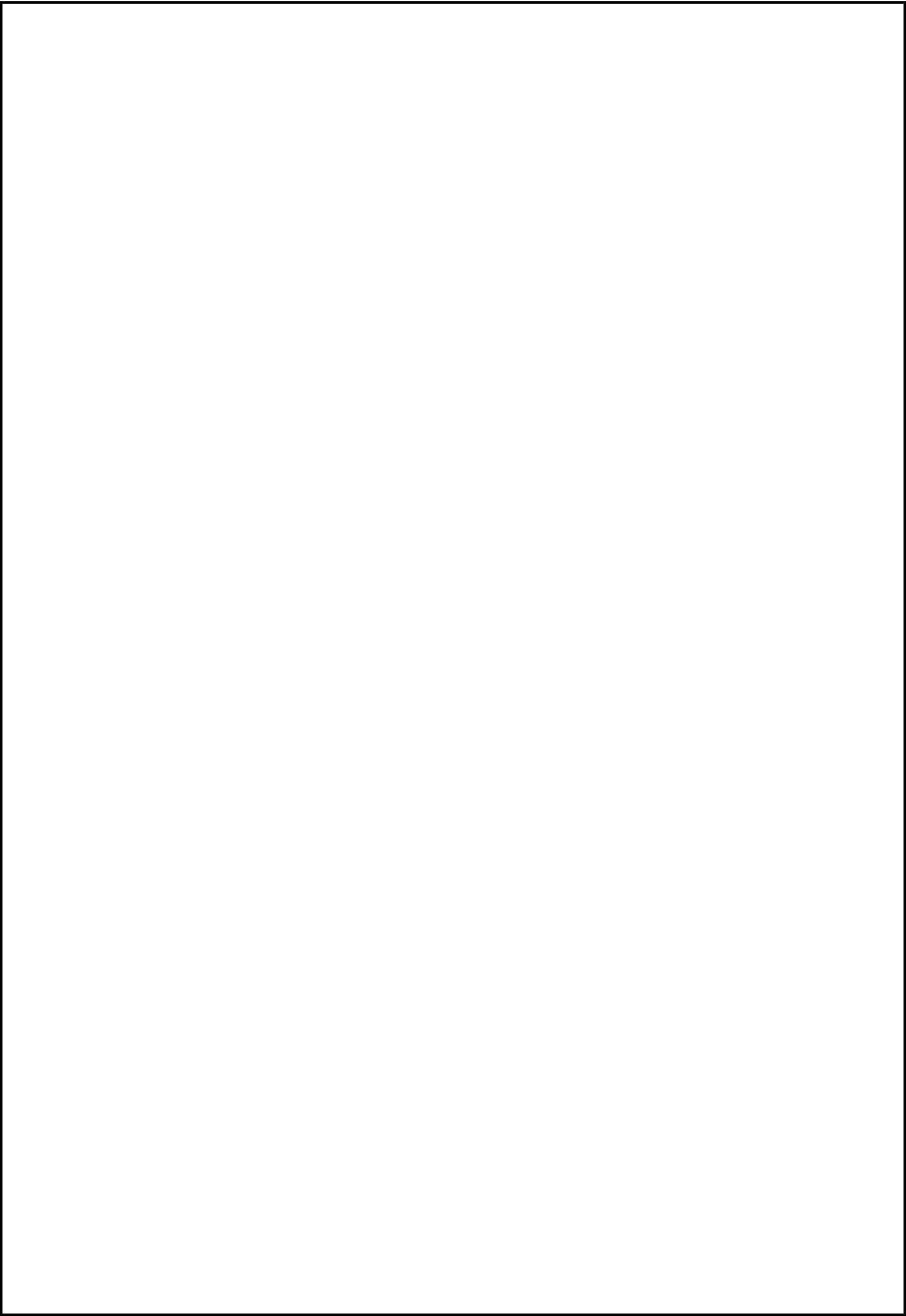

The hero Abdelkader Ibn Muhieddine known as El Emir Abdelkader was an Algerian religious man and a military leader. This great hero was born in 1807, in Guetna near Mascara, where he grew up and learnt the Quran as well as other subjects.

El Emir was a political leader and a brave warrior. He successfully faced the French army and saved the Christian community of Damascus from a massacre, in 1860. So, this intervention, which is now called the human rights, brought him admiration and awards from around the world.

This hero won many battles against the French army. Among his most famous battles are The Battle of Maktaa, The Battle of Sig and The Battle of Sidi Brahim. The French army feared El Emir because they were attacked unexpectedly by his army. He defended his land and protected the Algerian values, language and religion to keep the Algerians unified against their enemy. However, El Emir's rebellion ended up and he was forced to surrender. In 1848, he was transferred with his family and followers to the Château d' Amboise.

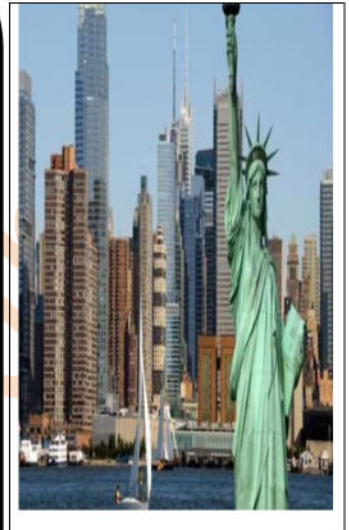

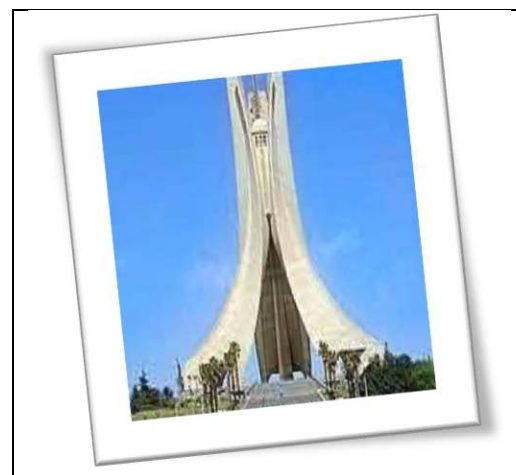

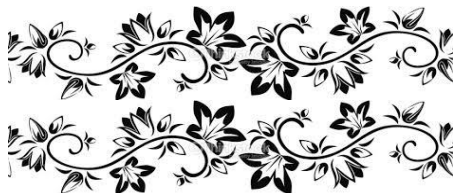
It was built to commemorate the sacrifice of the million martyr who died for the independence of the country.
