

In ancient times, housework was hard because homes didn't have water or electricity. One of the most difficult household activities was washing clothes. People took their dirty clothes to the river once or twice a week and used rocks, sand and water to clean them. For many years, people tried to find easier ways to wash their clothes. Sailors, for example, put their clothes in bags and threw them into the sea. This method worked quite well because the moving water helped.



In 1846, the first washing machine was invented, but it was difficult to use. The water was cold, so people warmed it on a fire. Then they pulled the clean wet clothes through a special machine to take out the water.

The first electronic washing machine was designed in 1908. It was more useful because it could warm the water but it wasn't working properly, the clothes were still very wet. The First Flying machine

A thousand years before The Wright brothers, a Muslim poet, astronomer, musician and engineer named Abbas Ibn Firnas was the first man who made several attempts to construct a flying machine.

In 852, he jumped from the minaret of the Grand Mosque in Cordoba using a loose cloak stiffened with wooden struts. He hoped to glide like a bird, but he didn't. The cloak slowed his fall creating what is thought the first parachute and leaving him with only minor injuries.

In 875, he tried again with a machine which he made of silk and eagles' feathers. Jumping from a mountain, he flew to a significant height and stayed for ten minutes. But crashed on landing because he had not given his device a tail. Baghdad international airport and a crater on the Moon are named after him.


