

Mahmoud Darwish

Mahmoud Darwish was a well known Palestinian poet and writer, born on March 13th, 1941, in the village of Al-Birwa in Palestine.

He grew up during difficult times, and this shaped his thoughts and writings. Darwish wrote poems that talked about his homeland, identity, freedom, and the daily struggles of his people. His words were powerful, emotional, and full of hope, which made him one of the most important modern Arab poets.



Throughout his career, he published many poetry collections such as "Unfortunately, It Was Paradise," and "Why Did You Leave the Horse Alone?" His poems were translated into many languages, and he received several international awards. Mahmoud Darwish died in 2008, but his poetry continues to inspire millions around the world. He is remembered as the "voice of Palestine" and one of the greatest poets of the Arab world.
